This grade of Santoprene® TPV is shear-dependent and can be processed on conventional thermoplastics equipment for injection molding or blow molding. It is polyolefin based and recyclable within the manufacturing stream.

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

# **Processing Notes**

Desiccant drying for 3 hours at 80 °C (180 °F) can be performed if desired. Santoprene® TPV has a wide temperature processing window from 175 to 230 °C (350 to 450 °F) and is incompatible with acetal and PVC.
